

WATER TREATMENT CHANGE NOTICE

ON MAY 31st WE WILL BE CONVERTING OUR WATER TREATMENT FROM MONOCHLORAMINES (CHLORINE GAS AND LIQUID AMMONIA) TO FREE CHLORINE (CHLORINE GAS ONLY) AS PER STATED BY TCEQ. THIS IS SOMETHING WE ARE REQUIRED TO DO EVERY JUNE. AS THE TREATMENT PROCESS TRANSITIONS FROM ONE TO THE OTHER, THERE WILL BE A SLIGHT CHLORINE SMELL IN THE WATER. DON'T BE ALARMED, IT'S NATURAL AS THE PROCESS CHANGES. OUR WATER WILL STILL BE IN THE RANGE OF LEVELS OF DOSAGE REQUIRED. THE SMELL WILL DISSIPATE IN A COUPLE OF DAYS. ON JULY 1ST , WE WILL TRANSITION BACK TO MONOCHLORAMINES AND THERE WILL ALSO BE A SLIGHT CHANGE IN THE SMELL OF OUR WATER FOR A COUPLE OF DAYS.
